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In My Opinion

We Have Become Data Entry Specialists Emily Dalton, M.D.

When people ask me "What do you do" these days I jokingly answer "data entry specialist". Unfortunately, it's kind of true. I probably spend more time sitting at the computer clicking boxes and keyboarding phrases than I do talking with my patients. Even with the use of dictation software, charting takes a lot of time. It seems like most electronic medical record systems are designed to force clinicians to do an enormous amount of data entry. What happened to the idea that computers are supposed to make things easier for the user?

In my opinion I should be able to dictate an entire note quickly and efficiently and the software program should sort the data and place it in the proper locations in the chart. Think how much faster your note writing would be if you could just dictate: "History" ...so-and -so... then, "Physical Exam": ...such-and-such, and so on. Currently most programs require clinicians to scroll through various sections of the chart, painstakingly clicking on little dots or boxes next to various items. After doing this for decades, my right arm finally wore out. I was in so much pain that I had to switch to a left handed mouse. That is awkward to say the least. Maybe with the advent of AI we will see some advances in that direction.

One might think that having a scribe would be a good solution to this problem, and in many instances it can be. Those of you who have scribes are probably able to focus more on patient care than entering chart notes. Scribes come with their own set of problems however. Scribes

are expensive, and they

can make the exam room crowded. I frequently see families that have several children, two or more parents or relatives present, and I often have a student or a resident doing training. Once we get more than 4 or 5 people in a small exam room it is almost impossible to work.

In conclusion, I hope that the electronic medical record designers will take heed and try to craft software with ease of use in mind during future upgrades. Physicians should be able to prioritize time with patients and minimize time spent entering data. Emily Dalton, M.D. §
